I remember how I felt as a child, never seeing myself reflected in books. I didn't want my children to have the same feeling of not belonging or that they didn't matter.

It was then I decided to write Children of the Quicksands for my daughters. I was angry about the boring and vague image of Africa, which did not allow the beauty of its many countries to shine through. So I wrote a magical adventure story set in Nigeria.

## Efua Traoré's book

When I moved to Germany at the age of 18, I left behind Lagos – a 20 million-strong mega-city with afrobeats booming from loudspeakers, traffic jams that reached from the mainland and crossed the blue shimmering lagoon.

To my surprise, when I got to Germany, I found out that I came from a dull, indistinct place at the bottom of the globe called Africa – known for its poor, black-skinned people living in rural places.

I was shocked. An entire continent of over a billion people, more than 50 countries, 2,000 languages, diverse cultures, religions and brilliant attires reduced to this one sad image.
