

# How to Leaf Bash

You will need:

- 2 pieces of Fabric
- Hard surface or board
- Masking tape
- Hammer
- Leaves and flowers
- String/stick/stapler (optional)



What to do:

1. Lay one piece of fabric on your board.
2. Tape your fabric down with masking tape.
3. Lay your leaves and flowers on your fabric. (use whole leaves with interesting shapes and small flowers for the best effects)
4. Cover with another piece of fabric.
5. Tape fabric down.
6. Now bash all over with a hammer until
7. the die/chlorophyll prints onto the fabric.
8. Remove the tape and bashed leaves to reveal your print.



Some ideas to try:

Fold over the edge of your fabric to make a slot. Staple or stick it down. Slot in a stick to make a flag.



Use triangle pieces of fabric and then stick onto a long piece of string to make your own bunting. We use double sided tape but use what you can find at home.
